The ability to teach up to GCSE is essential and the ability to teach A level would be preferable but opportunities, training and support would be put in place if you have not taught A level before. Excellent opportunities for personal development exist as part of our CPD and training programme as well as mentoring and supporting within Essex Schools ITT.

Science is a very popular subject with our students and we have some of the best results in the county for both A level and GCSE.

Davenant is a Christian Ecumenical Church of England school that was founded in 1680. It achieves outstanding examination results, has a strong focus on extra-curricular provision and seeks to nurture "mind, body and spirit". We are a supportive school with a staff welfare programme that reflects our care.

Davenant is recognised as a "good school, with an outstanding Sixth Form" by Ofsted. Academic standards are high (In 2024 we were again one of the highest achieving schools in Essex). Many of our students move on to take degrees at university (including Cambridge and Oxford).
